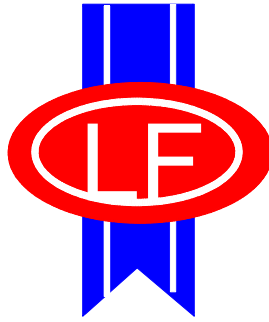


Looking After your Hardwood Windowboards



Helpful Hints

Step 1

Clean any dirt from the exterior or interior of the frames with a soft brush and wipe with a dry cloth

Step 2

Lightly sand the wood with a 400 grit paper and again wipe dust away

Step 3

With a paint brush apply the stain of your choice to the frame avoiding getting it on the Aluminium frames. If you do get it on the Aluminium then wipe away gently with some white spirit on your rag

Step 4

When you are happy with the colour stop applying the stain

NOTE

We recommend you do not use a varnish on the exterior hardwood frame work



Brown Mahogany

Material Required

400 Grit Sandpaper
Colour Wood Stain ~ Dulux Base Coat if Necessary then the relevant Top Coat
Colour
White Spirit
Towelling Rag or Cotton Rag
Linseed Oil



Natural Teak

The Dulux Base coat is a liquid preservative rather than one of the congealed type, we recommend the Dulux base coat (Light or Dark Colour) to enable the hardwood to soak it up,
